# GOLF





### JUNIOR ACTIVITIES

# Brookside has a range of activities to keep kids busy throughout the summer.

Junior Tennis summer camps are offered to fit into your busy summer schedule. After school tennis begins in May and is held on Tuesdays and Thursdays until the end of the school year.

Brookside's Swim and Dive Team, the Water Buffaloes, compete in the Private Country Club Athletic League (PCCAL). Members' children, ages five through high school, can enjoy the fun of swimming and diving. Workouts are held mid-morning and the meets are held on Mondays. Districts and Championships are held in Mid-July with an awards banquet at the end of the season.

Group and private swim lessons are available under the instruction of Brookside's certified lifeguards.

KidZone is staffed by American Red Cross certified personnel and features an air hockey table, x-box, books, board games, coloring activities, separate infant area, movies and crafts. Children may order lunch or dinner from the Brookside Children's menu and eat in the KidZone while their parents enjoy dining or other activities at their club. The KidZone features multiple fun activities and summer camps and is one of the most popular offerings at Brookside for our youngest members ages 6 weeks – 12 years.

# SOCIAL MEMBERSHIP

Social members and their families enjoy full clubhouse, athletic facility and limited golf privileges.

These benefits include the fitness center, swimming pool, tennis courts, clubhouse, dining, event facilities, social events and KidZone.

Social members and their families receive golf course access up to five times per calendar year upon payment of the social greens fee. Social members may make tee times one day in advance and have driving range privileges up to one hour before their scheduled tee time.
